**1940**      **LEARNING STRATEGIES**      **Prerequisite:** Must have current IEP  
**Length:** 1 Year      **Credit:** 1.00 Elective

**COURSE DESCRIPTION:** This course introduces and reinforces study skills that will enable special need students to perform better in their other classes. Additionally, I.E.P. goals and objectives are addressed through this course.

**1941/1942**      **LANGUAGE STRATEGIES/WRITING STRATEGIES**      **Prerequisite:** Recommendation of resource teacher  
**Length:** 1 Year      **Credit:** 1.00 Elective/1.00 English

**COURSE DESCRIPTION:** This course introduces and reinforces language skills in the areas of: semantics, syntax, morphology, and pragmatic. The course focuses on: comprehension, vocabulary, daily oral and written language, overall comprehension and use of language skills. IEP language goals and objectives are addressed through this course.

**I #**      **I. E. P. Classes**      **Prerequisite:** Must have current IEP  
**Length:** 1 Semester - 2 Semesters      **Credit:** Varies

**COURSE DESCRIPTION:** I. E. P. (Individualized Education Plan) classes are offered in a variety of academic areas each semester. Course offerings are based on student's individualized education plans. In addition to offering credit towards graduation, I. E. P. classes address planning for transition to post high school opportunities.
