

University of Missouri System Admission Requirements

The University of Missouri System requires for admission more academic high school credits in several academic areas than does the McCluer Comprehensive Diploma. Many four-year colleges follow these requirement guidelines. The McCluer Guidance Center has extensive college admission requirement information.

<u>English</u>	4.0 Credits	4 Credits Literature & Composition, American & Multicultural Literature, *Am. & Multi. Lit, (H) Am. & Multi. Lit., British and World Literature, *Brit. Lit., (H)Brit. Lit, Eng 12, *Eng 12, (H) Eng 12, Speech I, Speech II, Comm/Life Skills, Creative Writing, Readings in Literature, Applied Communication I, and Applied Communication II.
<u>Math</u>	2 Credits	4 Credits Algebra I, Geometry I, (H) Geometry II, Algebra II/Trig, (H) Algebra II/Trig, Functions/Statistics/Discrete Math, (H) Pre-Calculus, and (H) Calculus. • Note: Math must be Algebra I or higher. This requirement may be satisfied by the completion of course in middle school, junior high school, or senior high school.
<u>Science</u>	2 Credits	3 Credits Physical Science, Chemistry, (H) Advanced Chemistry, Physics, (H) Physics, Biology, Field Biology, Birds & Mammals, (H) Adv. Biology--A & P, (H) Adv. Biology--M & G, Astronomy & Weather, and Solid Earth. • Note: Science must include a laboratory course. General Science may not be included. This requirement may be satisfied by the completion of courses in the middle school, junior high school, or senior high school.
<u>Social Studies</u>	3 Credits	3 Credits Citizenship/Government, Geography/Economics, American History, (H) American History, World History, (H) World Studies, and (H) Intro to American Politics.
<u>Foreign Languages</u>	None	2 Credits French, German, or Spanish. • Note: Foreign Language must be completed in the same language. This requirement may be satisfied by the completion of courses in the middle school, junior high school, or senior high school.
