During these events' information regarding programming at Combs Intermediate School will be provided. Below are additional services students, teachers, and or families that are identified in our Title I Schoolwide plan for the 2021-2022 school year:

Title I and ESSER funds will be spent in the following ways:

- Positions that support student academic success: Supplemental Reading/Math teachers and Class Size Reduction teachers provide smaller classes and groups
- Positions that support student social support: Social workers and SEL teachers will assist students with proactive strategies to deal with attendance, trauma and social concerns
- Instructional Support Leader (ISL) positions support teachers by providing job embedded professional development to support student learning
- Teacher training for technology, social emotional learning, academic standards and content

The Importance of Attendance

Our attendance goal is: 90% of our students present 90% of the time. We need the assistance of all stakeholders because regular attendance has a huge impact on students' academic success. The principal reiterated the importance of children attending school every day and arriving on time.

Parents' Right to Know

- Teachers must be appropriately certified to teach
- Parents have a right to know the qualifications of their child's teacher.
- Parents will be notified if any services are provided by a paraprofessional.

• Parents will be notified if their child is taught by a teacher for four or more consecutive weeks who is not appropriately certified to teach a particular subject
