

COUNSELOR'S CORNER NEWSLETTER



Parent/teacher conferences are just around the corner. The dates for conferencing are listed under *Important Dates*. Please make sure you schedule a time to meet with your child's teacher to discuss your concerns about academics, behavior, or anything else you believe would be pertinent to the success of your child. Again the district will be using **MyConference Time** to schedule parent/teacher conferences. This year conferences for Duchesne will occur on Monday, October 24 and Wednesday, October 26. Both days will have conferences from 4:30 pm until 7:30 pm.

For the month of October guidance will be provided by Child Abuse Prevention Program to all students kindergarten through 2nd grade. The focus of the lesson will be Safe Touch. The goal of the program is to provide age-appropriate information on the concepts of personal safety, boundaries, and bodily autonomy.
