NEW VOTING PROCEDURE FOR FFSD TO ELECT BOARD OF EDUCATION DIRECTORS

The voting procedure used to elect school board members in the Ferguson-Florissant School District has changed.

In cumulative voting, voters can cast as many votes as there are seats up for election. You can give more than one vote to a single candidate. For instance, there are two seats open in this board election. You can cast both your votes for one candidate or one vote each to two different candidates.

In the April 2019 election, FFSD will have two seats open for Board of Education directors. You will have up to two votes to cast. You can cast both your votes for one candidate or one vote each to two different candidates. You are not required to cast both of your votes. The two candidates with the most votes will be elected.

You can cast your two votes for the same candidate or you can distribute your votes among two candidates. You are not re-quired to cast both of your votes, but you cannot cast more than two votes.
