- Planning & coaching sessions for the new ELA curriculum (Wit & Wisdom)
- Therapeutic classroom

Building Goals

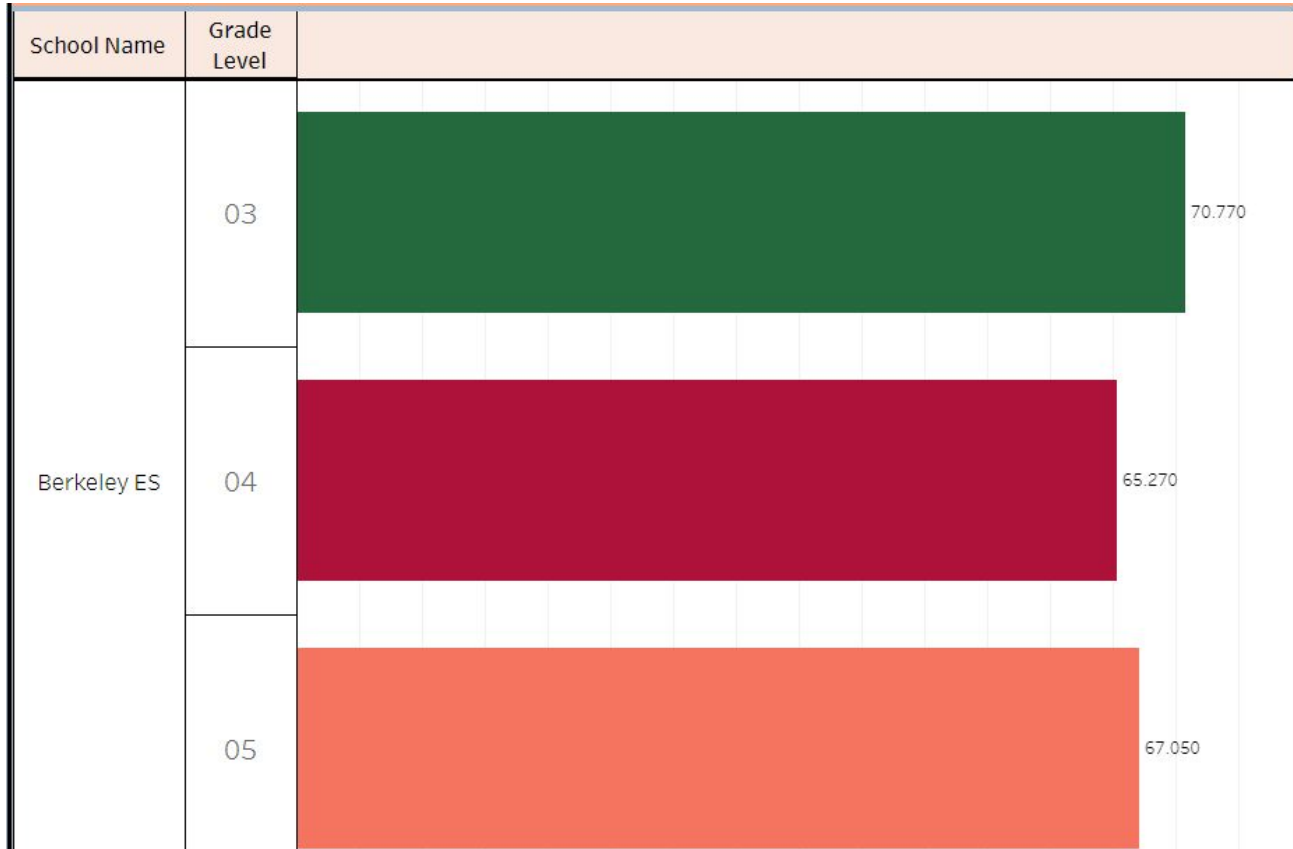
- The number of students in BB will decrease by 5% building wide in math and ELA as measured from Galileo benchmark 1 to Galileo benchmark 3. (Instructional goal)
- Berkeley will schedule four family fun events that occur after a PTO meeting to encourage at least 25% of our parents to attend for the purpose of improving our partnership between home and school. (Climate & Culture goal)
- BK will improve Tier 1 implementation by aligning PBIS building wide behavioral universals with effective classroom practices and the implementation of No Nonsense Nurturer as evidenced by effective teacher evaluation scores and a decrease in discipline referrals in the area of disruptive behaviors by 25% by the end of the 2024-2025 school year. (SEL/Behavior goal)
- At least 80% of the students at BK will be in attendance for at least 90% of the time during the 2024-2025 school year. (Attendance)

(% of students who met growth expectation from Benchmark 1 to Benchmark 3)

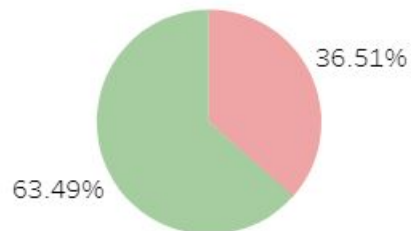
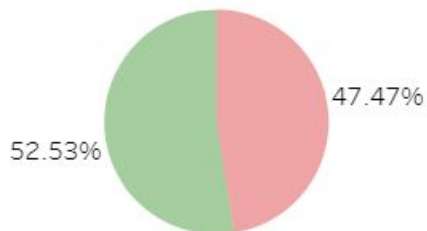

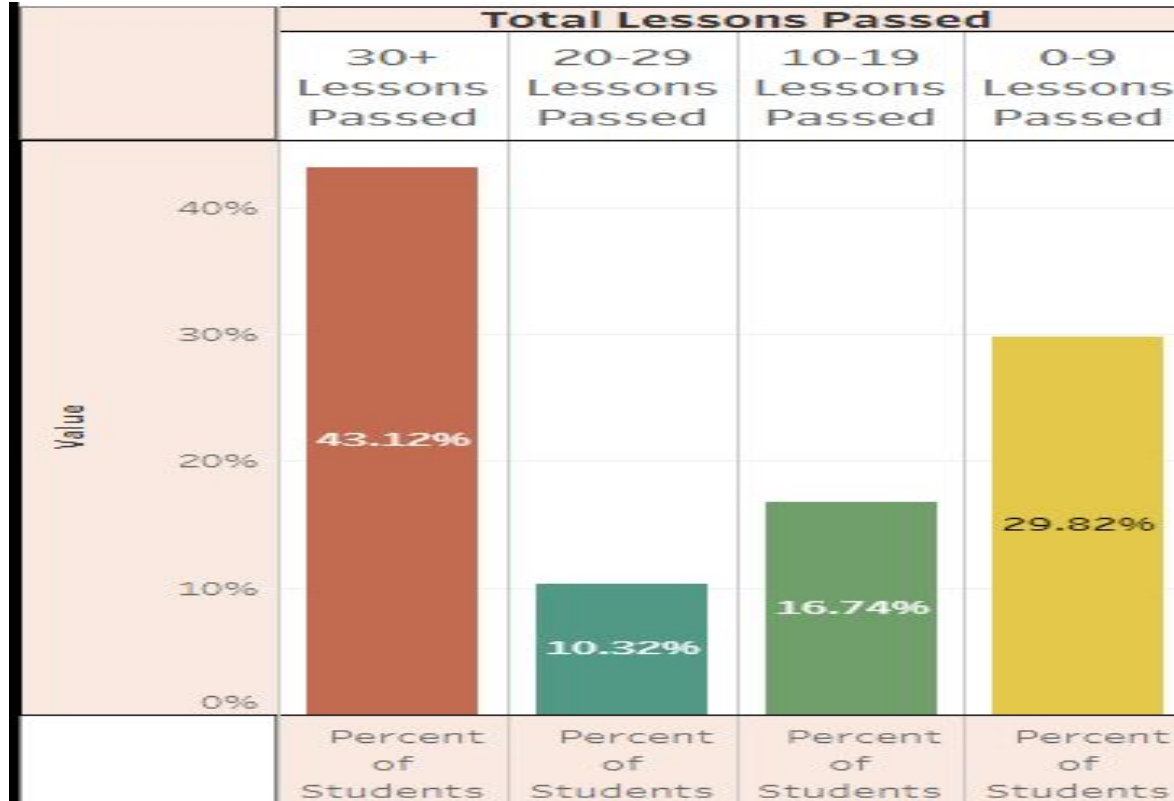

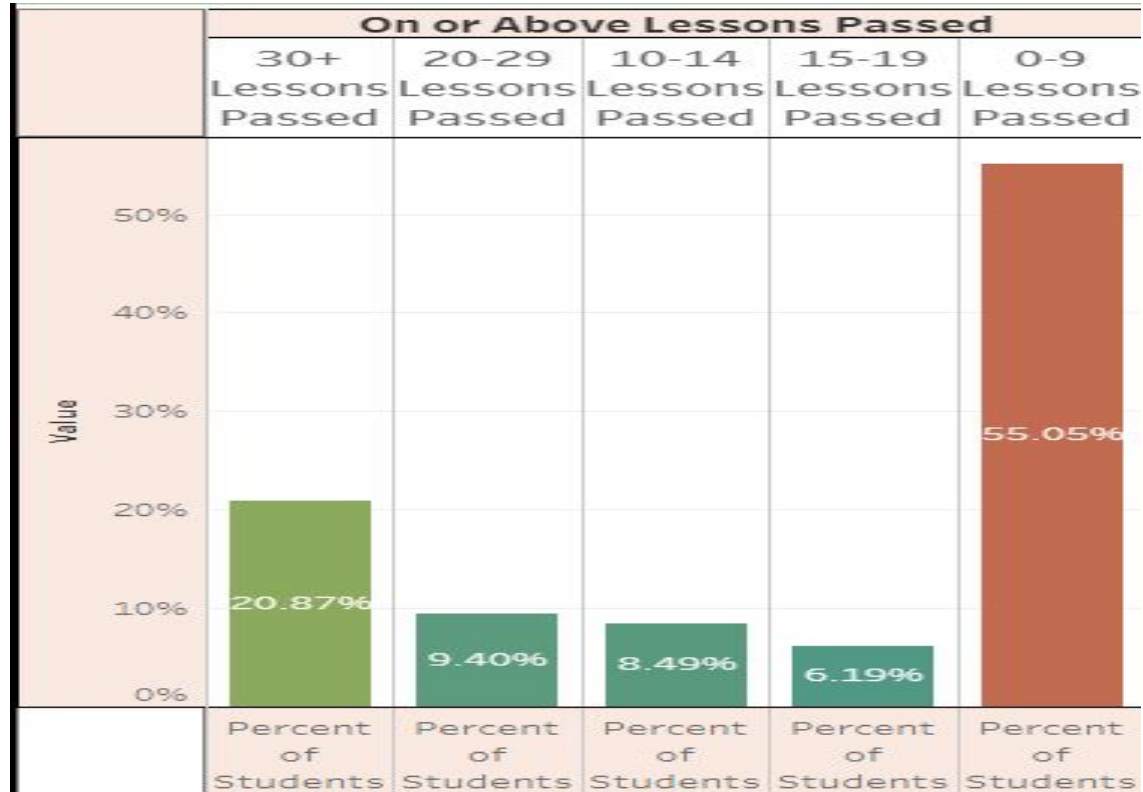

STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT DATA

Strengths-ISL coaching of teachers and support with the implementation of Imagine Math, Lang. and Lit. and the new ELA curriculum (Wit & Wisdom and UFLI), materials and supplies for teachers to support ELA curriculum, MySci curriculum, increased usage of Imagine Math and Lang. and Lit, and weekly PLC meetings to focus on improving instruction and increasing student achievement

Weaknesses- Need for more small group instruction, implementation of all components within ELA & math to allow students to grapple with more challenging tasks, and more scaffolding within subjects for learners below grade level to prepare them for independent work, and the need to ensure a building wide focus on data sharing with students multiple times per quarter

STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT DATA

Needs/Action Steps- ISL to support teachers with the implementation of Wit & Wisdom lessons during planning sessions and observations, PLC support and support with our professional learning cycles, after school tutoring in the areas of math and/or reading, bus transportation for after school tutoring, and building wide reading/math intervention for all students who are not performing on grade level

CURRICULUM DATA

Strengths- Social Emotional Learning Curriculum, Imagine Math & Lang and Lit implementation, MySci, weekly PLC meetings, and coaching/planning support and feedback for new ELA curriculum and math

Weaknesses- Building wide utilization of student data to incorporate small group instruction during ELA & math and bi-weekly progress monitoring aligned to district benchmarks and state standards)

STAFF WILL...

- Assist students in reaching their fullest potential with the belief that all children can learn and be successful.
- Provide ongoing oral and written communication to parents and students regarding performance and assessment results.

- Support all students with self-regulation and strategies for regulating their emotions.

ATTENDANCE MATTERS

- Missing 10% or about 2 days each month over the course of a school year, can make it harder to learn to read
- Students can still fall behind if they miss 1 or 2 days every few weeks
- Being late to school can lead to poor attendance
- Absences and tardiness can affect the whole classroom if the teacher has to slow down learning to help children catch up

ATTENDANCE MATTERS

- Students who arrive late must be signed in by an adult when entering the building
- Be sure to email the school or your child's teacher when they are absence for any reason, we must have documentation
- The goal is to have your child at school at least 90% of the time as it is difficult to make up missing work or time missed during instruction
- When students are sick please allow them to stay home
