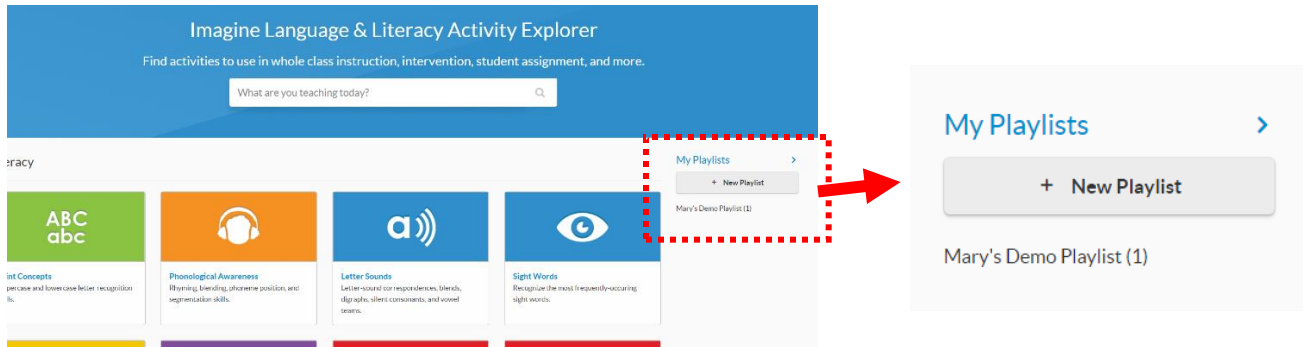
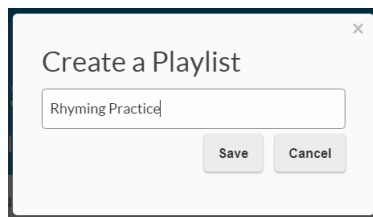


1. After you have checked the Action Areas to determine your student(s) need; open the Activity Explorer, click **New Playlist**.

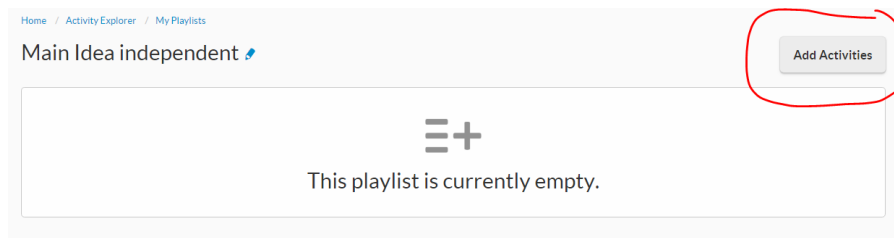


2. Type the name of the Playlist that you are creating, then click **Save**.

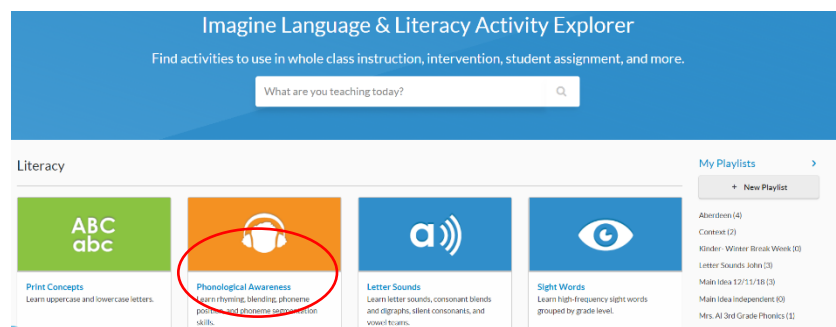


NOTE: You must have a group assigned to you in order to create playlists and assign playlists to students.

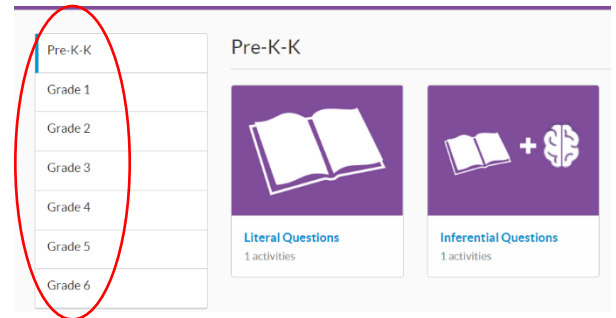
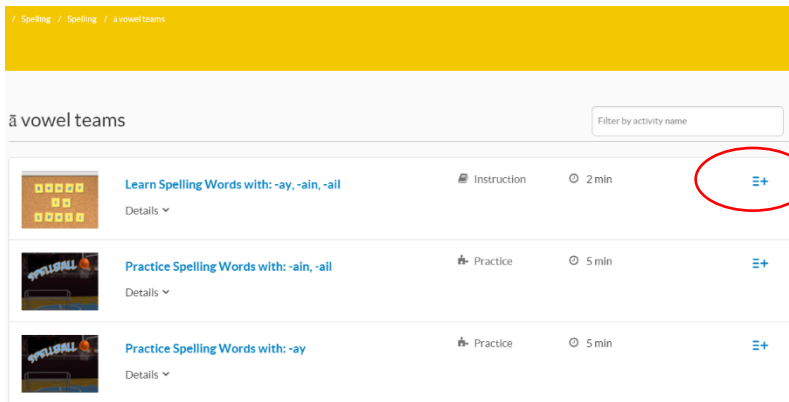
3. After you have created a playlist you can add activities to it. On the right side of the screen, click on the name of the Playlist you want to add activities to. *The maximum number of activities for any playlist is 7.*
4. Look for the **Add Activities** button: *After you have added activities, you can then begin adding Students to it.*



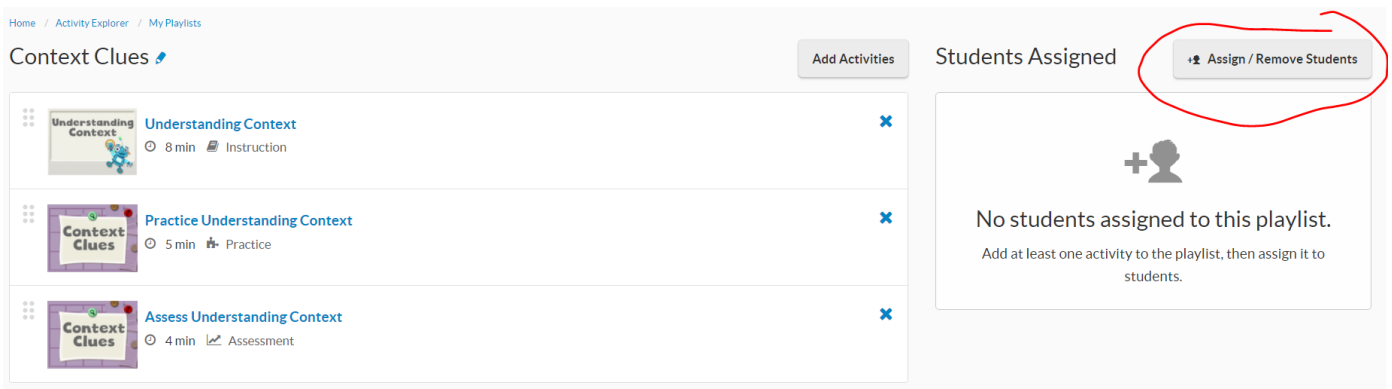
5. You can type in the search bar for activities to assign (not all items will appear) or I recommend opening the icons below the search bar to add activities:



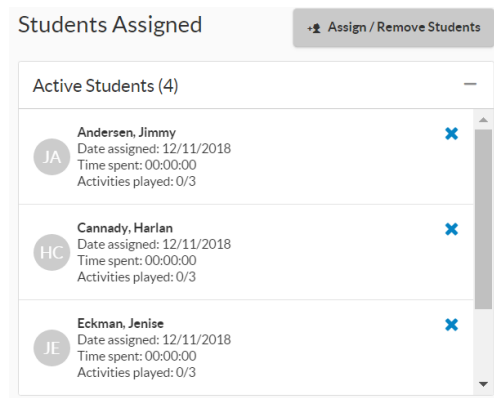
6. When you are ready to add the activities, click the plus button: *I recommend looking for introduction, practice and assessment sequences. There is a limit to 7 activities per Playlist. Keep an eye out for grade level options on the left side of the screen and in the details of the activities.*



7. Once you have added all your activities you are now ready to add students: *Students can only be assigned to one pathway at a time. Students must complete the assigned Playlist before resuming their individual pathway.*



8. When your students are assigned you will be able to keep track of their progress:
