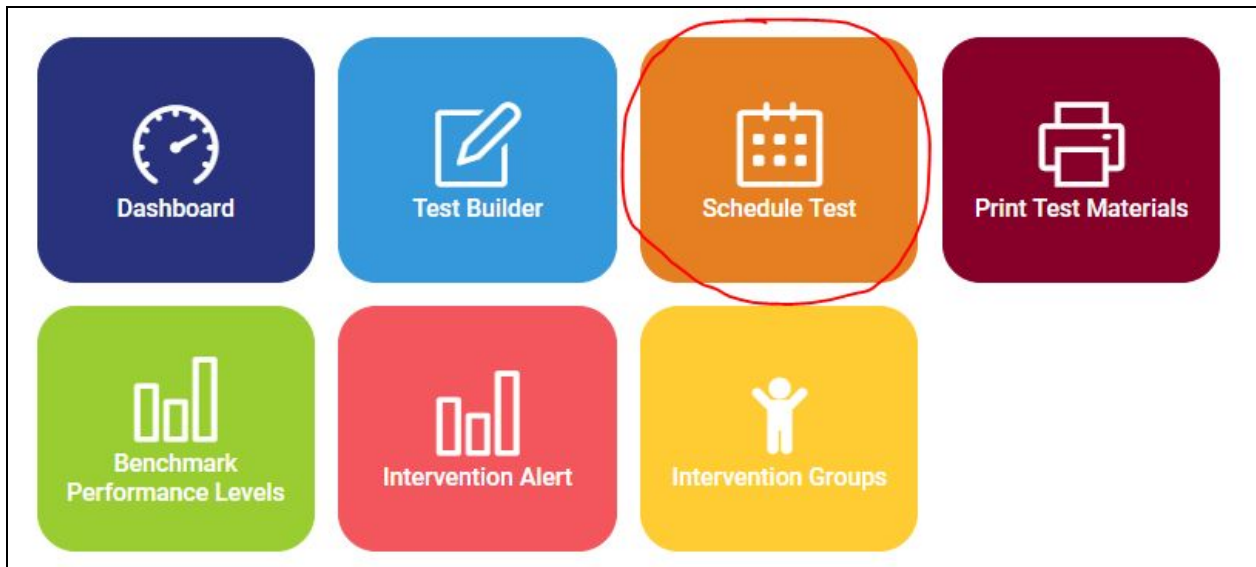



Text-to-Speech Access and Use in Galileo

Please follow the screen captures and explanations to access and use text-to-speech for Galileo Benchmarks

1) Select “Schedule Test” on your Galileo dashboard



2) Once you navigate to the next screen, select the appropriate Class, Library, Test, and Instructor of Record. Test libraries are organized by grade level. The libraries are entitled “2019-20 Ferguson-Florissant [grade level] Benchmark Library”.


