# **Berkeley Elementary Arriva/Dismissal Procedures and Schedule**

This year Berkeley Elementary - Grades 3-5 will use the following arrival and dismissal procedures. Please help us keep your children safe and the flow of traffic moving quickly by following these procedures.

# **Arrival Procedures**

### **Unleashing Potential ONLY**

6:30 a.m. - <u>Unleashing Potential</u> accepts ENROLLED ONLY students after parents sign-in.

### ALL STUDENTS

8:15 a.m. Students can enter the building to read silently. Bus students enter through the main parking lot doors, Car riders, cabs and walkers enter the front door.

- 8:35 a.m. Breakfast begins.
- 8:50 a.m. Breakfast ends.
- 8:50 a.m. Tardy Bell and Morning Announcements
- 8:55 a.m. Instruction begins at all grade levels.
- 9:05 Bell rings Late period starts and impacts attendance minutes.

### **Dismissal Procedures**

3:15 p.m. - Afternoon Announcements - Bell rings

3:20 p.m. - Instruction Ends and Dismissal Begins - All groups line up and assemble in hallways with teacher.

3:20 p.m. - Walkers - Teacher A walks all walkers to the east door and then the west door depending on the location of the grade level and escorts them across the east street and the driveway.

3:25 p.m. - Unleashing Potential (UP) Program - Teacher B walks students to cafe from classroom and leaves them with UP supervisors/staff. Students follow the UP procedures.

3:25 p.m. - Buses/Day Care Vans- Teacher C walks students to gym, supervises and then walks group to bus. Girls sit behind bus driver and boys sit on the opposite side of the bus driver.

3:30 p.m. Car/Cab Riders - Teacher D walks students to car rider dismissal location on first floor, out east side of building to car rider lanes and are called by radio to cars.

MIDDLE AND HIGH SCHOOL SIBLINGS - Older siblings will have a designated area to wait for students walking home. They will not be allowed to enter the building or be on the front near buses or cars during the pick up students early.

PARENTS PLEASE REMAIN IN YOUR CARS, BE PATIENT AND ALLOW ADULTS TO BRING YOUR CHILD TO THE CAR.

IF EARLY DISMISSAL IS MANDATORY, PLEASE CALL THE SCHOOL AND PICK UP YOUR CHILD PRIOR TO 3:00 P.M. ANY LATER PICK UPS WILL BE DISCOURAGED SINCE INSTRUCTION CONTINUES UNTIL 3:20 AND THEN THE DISMISSAL PROCESS BEGINS.
