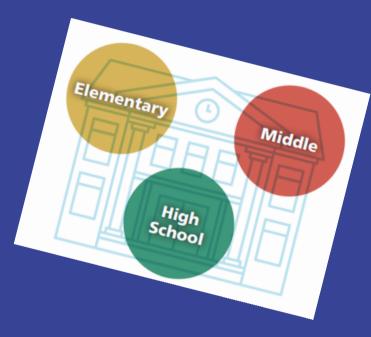


# **School Counseling Department**

### School Counseling Program
