Description of how strategy/strategies will provide

ISL will:
 Provide time for teachers to work collaboratively to analyze student work and assessment data to modify instruction.
 Work with classroom teachers to improve instructional practices and strategies.
 Teachers will be implementing complex grade level text and instructing students on how to utilize the close reading strategy to comprehend that text. Utilizing the close reading strategy is a district wide powerful practice.

- Use methods and instructional strategies that strengthen the academic program in the school.

Description of how strategy/strategies will strengthen

Mini-Lessons - provide a short focused lesson on a strategy or concept that allows teachers to model, explicitly teach, then have guided and independent practice. Mini-lessons allow for students to learn in small chunks and can be implemented in all content areas.
Guided Math - after presenting a math mini-lesson, teachers will assess the students using a quick check protocol. Teachers will intervene with students demonstrating misunderstandings before moving to another skill or concept.
Standards Based Planning - Teachers will plan based on the standard not the resource. Teachers will follow the curriculum pacing guide but will ensure that unit activities and assessments are aligned to a standard.
Data Analysis - Teachers will analyze data and create an action plan for students showing little or no growth during data team meetings once every 2 months.

 Small group support from social worker for students demonstrating difficulty in various areas.
 CHADS and Pinnocchio services for students demonstrating Tier 2 and 3 behaviors in and out of the classroom.
 Professional Development will be delivered monthly by the school district.
 The Instructional Leadership Team along with the Instructional Support Coach will provide ongoing school based professional development.
