Who can contact the Hotline?

- Employees from SafePlace site
- Youth 19 years and under
- Anyone concerned about a St. Louis County resident aged 19 or younger
- Family members
- Community members or agencies
- Law Enforcement

What happens when someone contacts the Hotline?

- A Master level or licensed clinician will focus on immediate need and provide support
- Ensure Safety of the caller
- When appropriate, outreaches will be provided by both Youth in Need and BHR
- BHR will respond when a mental health need is the primary problem.
- Youth in Need will respond when shelter/welfare needs are primary problems
- Follow up will occur within 48 business hours of initial call
- Follow up will be done weekly until linkage occurs
