# Consent for Standing Orders

Please review the approved Medical substances and emergency medications for the health room. These items may be used during the care of your child should the need arise. Contact the school nurse at your child's location if you have concerns about the use of any of the items listed below.

## Medical Substances:

1. **Benzalkonium Chloride Antiseptic Cleansing Towlette, Betadine, Providone Iodine Prep Pads, Vaseline, Alcohol or Hydrogen Peroxide:** to apply locally for minor abrasions, cuts, and chapped lips. **District provides.**
2. **Calamine:** itchy rash/insect bites. **District provides.**
3. **Calcium Carbonate/Tums:** minor upset stomach. **Parent provides.**
4. **Meat tenderizer Paste:** applied to bee sting initially to draw out bee venom. **District provides.**
5. **Hydrocortisone 1% Cream:** itching due to eczema, psoriasis, poison ivy, and bee stings **District provides.**
6. **Heating Pad, on "Low setting:"** only for dysmenorrheal or muscle soreness (*middle and high school students only*).
7. **Neosporin Ointment or Generic Brand Triple Antibiotic Ointment:** apply locally for minor cuts and abrasions. **District provides.**
8. **Eye Wash (sterile irrigating solution):** eye irrigation. **District provides.**

**Emergency Medication:** *Emergency Medication will only be administered during a medical emergency.*

2. **Epipen/Epipen Junior**
